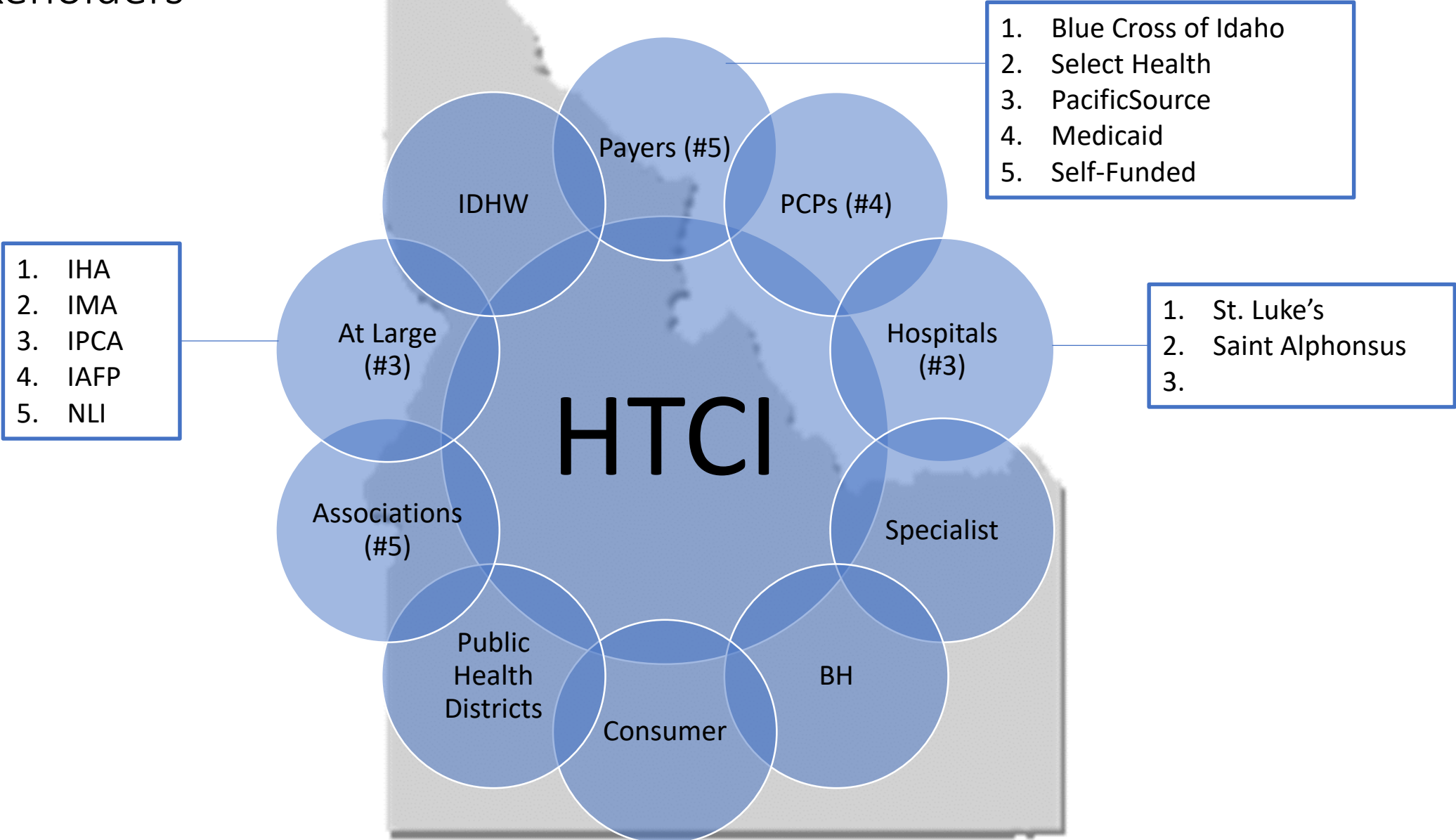


Healthcare Transformation Council of Idaho

HTCI Functions

- Promote and support transformation **by identifying opportunities for innovation** that will help shape the future of healthcare.
- Serve as a **trusted source and a credible voice** to strategically drive improvements in the healthcare delivery system.
- Serve as a **convener** of a broad-based set of stakeholders.
- **Identify delivery system barriers** that are preventing healthcare transformation and prioritize and recommend solutions.
- **Promote alignment** of the **delivery system** and **payment models** to drive sustainable healthcare transformation.
- Recommend and promote strategies to **reduce overall health care costs**.
- **Utilize accurate and timely data** to identify strategies and drive decision making for healthcare transformation.
- Promote **improved population health** through policies and best practices that improve access, quality, and the health of all Idahoans.
- Promote **whole person integrated care**, health equity, and recognize the impact of social determinants of health.
- Support the efforts in Idaho to provide a **healthcare workforce** that is sufficient in numbers and training to meet the demand.
- Promote efficiencies in the collection, measuring, and reporting of **quality metrics**.

4. PCMH training and technical assistance

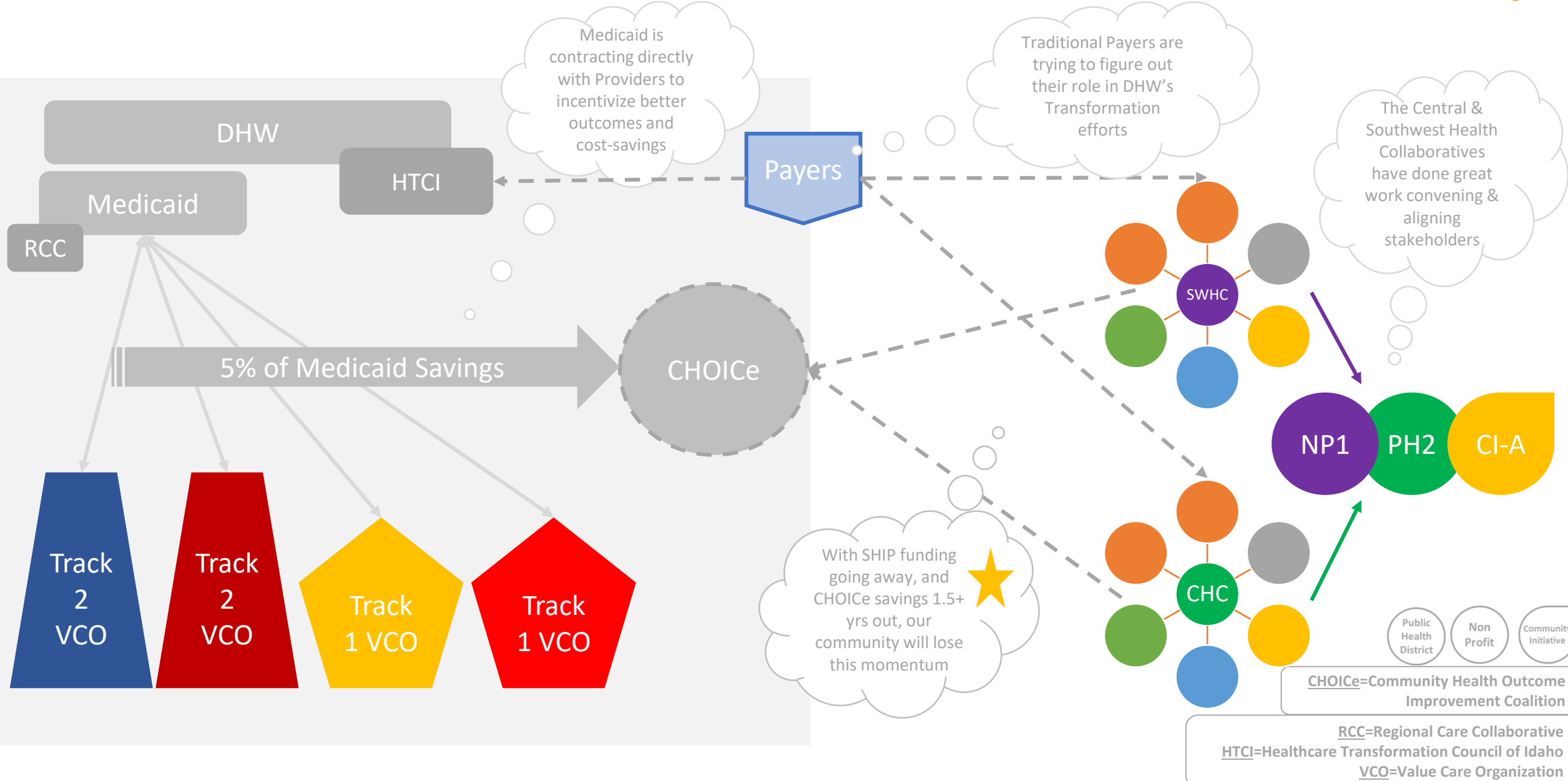

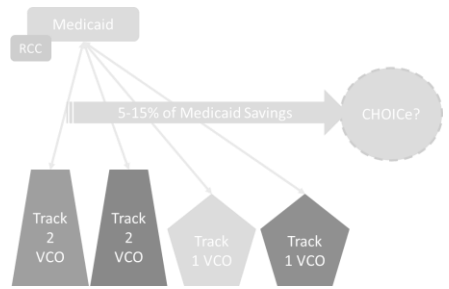

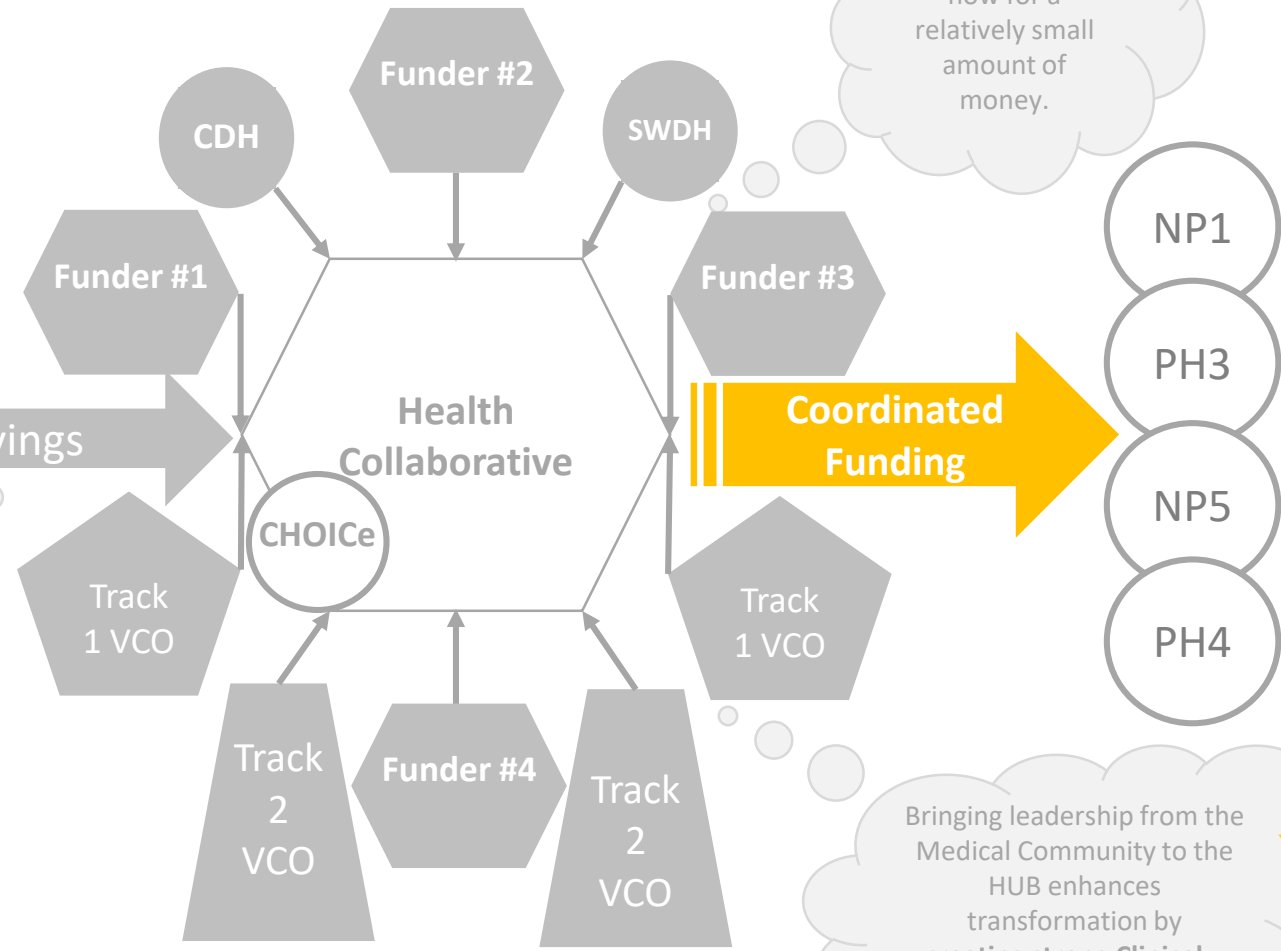
Healthcare leaders are attempting to drive transformation in Idaho

We can do this now for a relatively small amount of money.

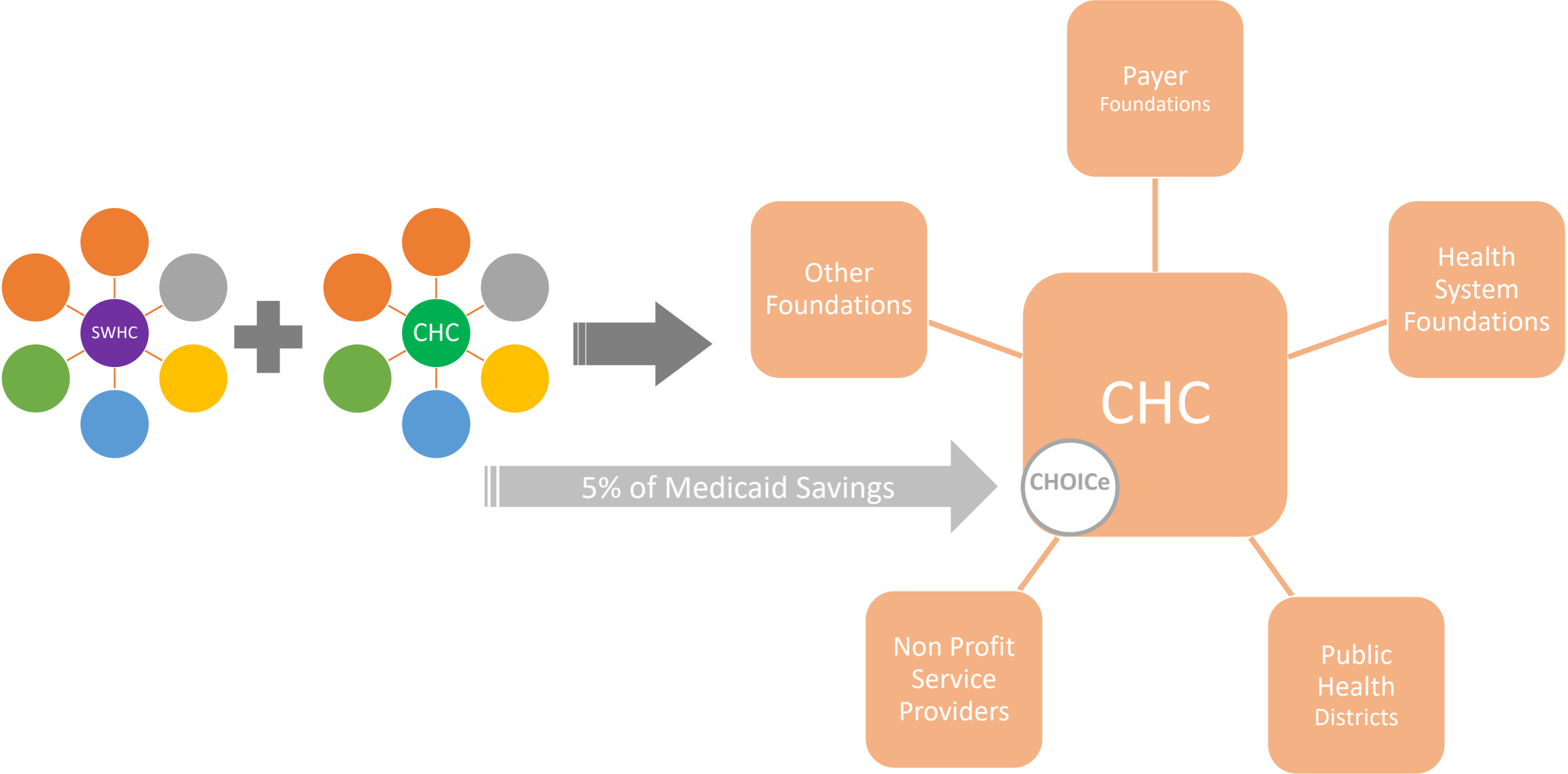
If we can come together to prioritize efforts and align resources our impact would be much greater.

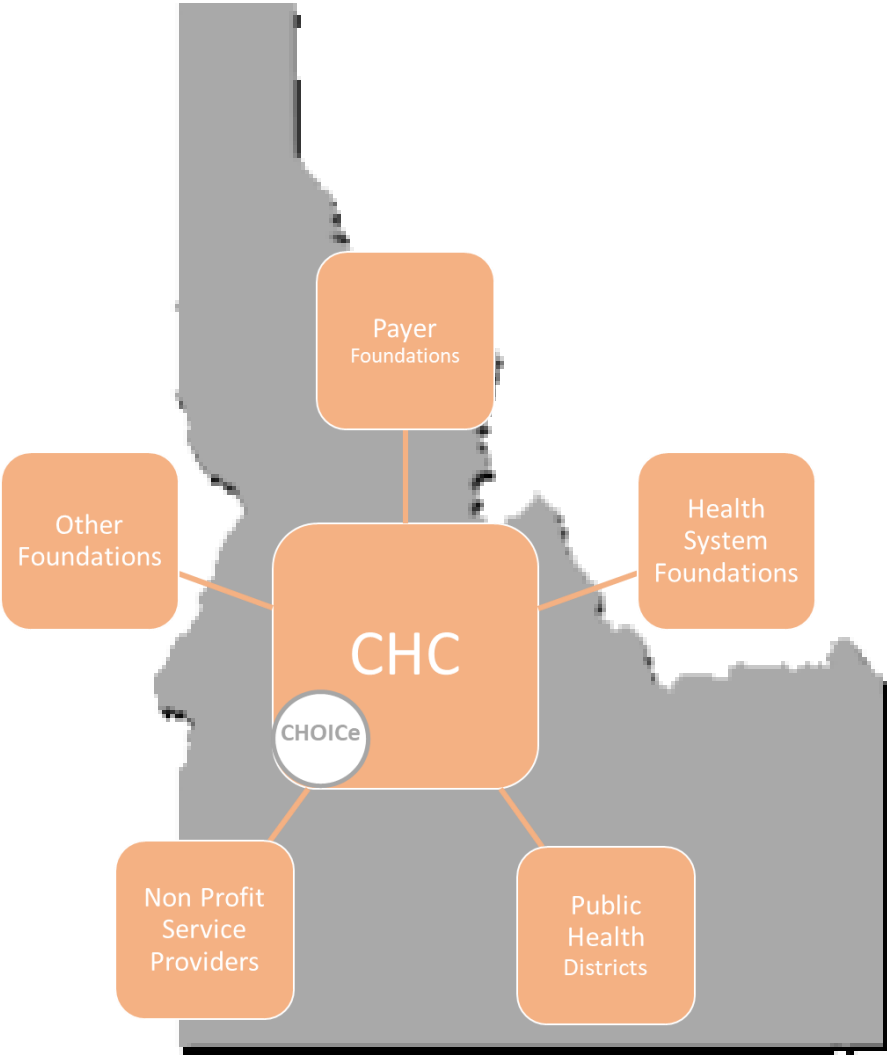

CHC Functions - *DRAFT*

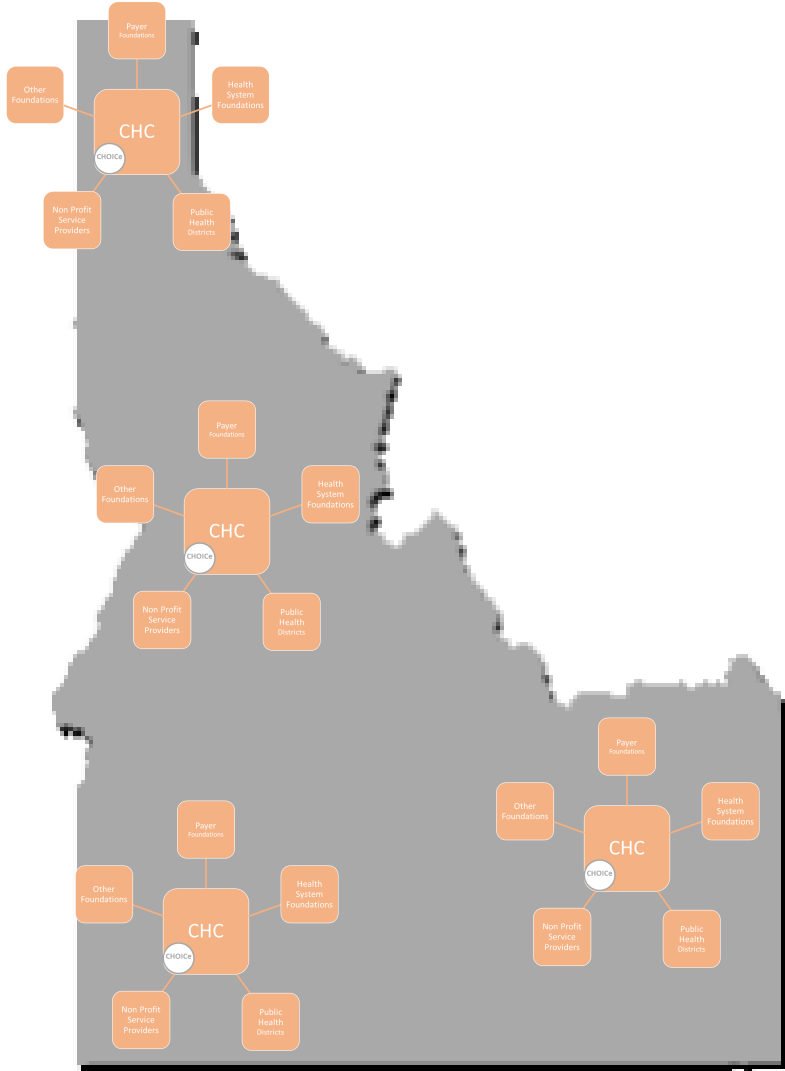
- Serve as a convener of regional partners who are invested in the transformation of Community Health.
- In partnership with HTCI, agree to a common vernacular and promote broad understanding of Population Health & Community Health.
- Identify policy, system, & environmental barriers that are negatively impacting health outcomes and driving up the cost of healthcare.
- Collect, analyze, & consolidate data that helps to identify the greatest drivers of poor Community Health Outcomes.
- Coordinate efforts & funding amongst partnered organizations to establish a single Regional Health Assessment.
- Be a trusted source of information and a credible voice for the strategic improvement of Community Health.
- Establish a framework for evaluating Community Health drivers that can help to prioritize investment strategies.
- Generate local, regional, and national support for initiatives to transform the health of the community.
- Develop a funding model to coordinate community investments and create scaled transformation for prioritized Community Health drivers.
- Coordinate all strategic initiatives, policy statements, and transformation efforts with HTCI.

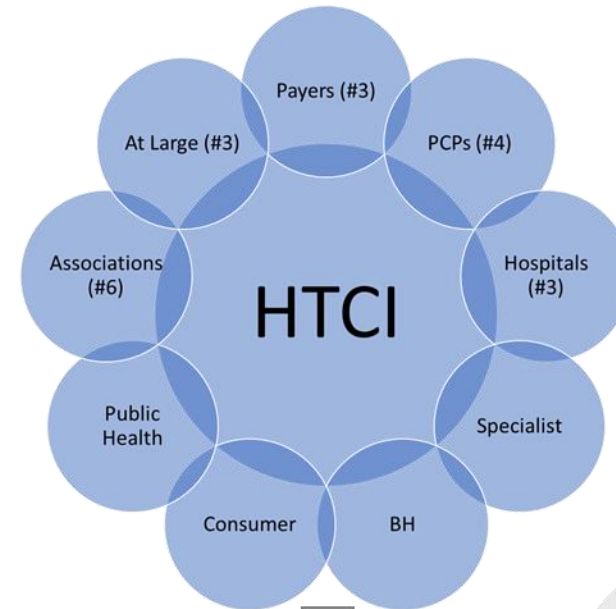
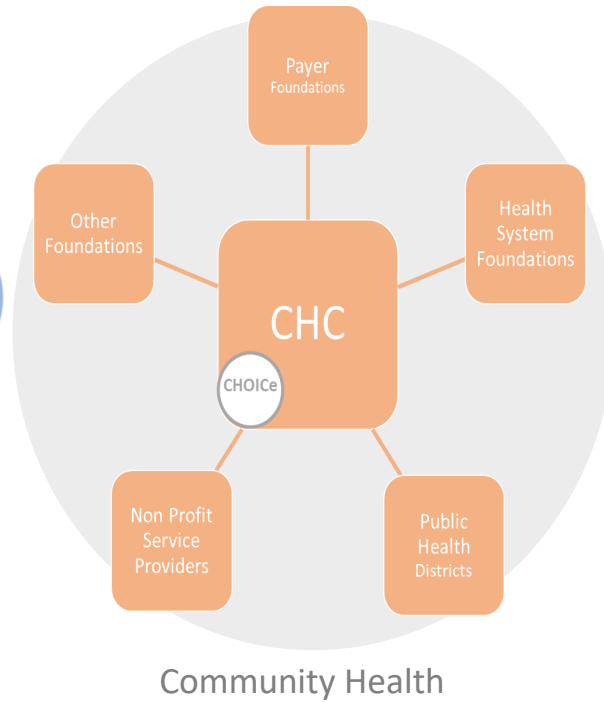
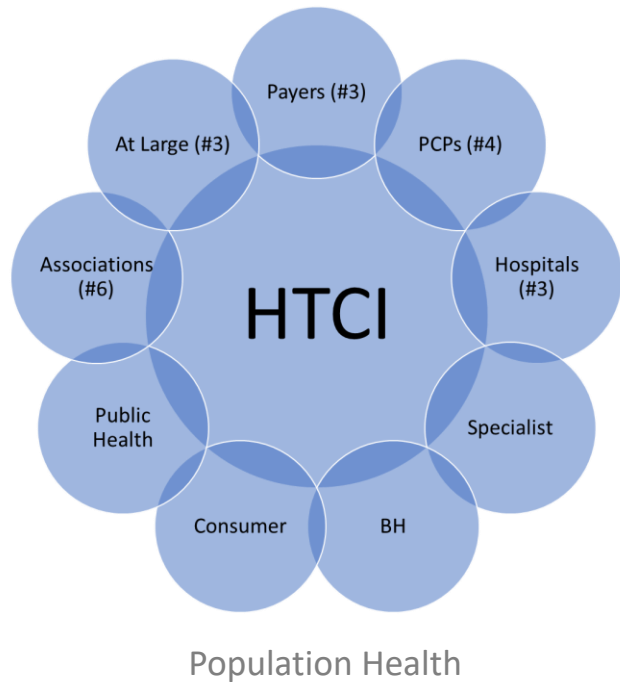
